Award Recipients Are Filled with Hometown Heart

Stanzione, speaking about Boykin Greenberg said, "Debbi has striven to promote and lift up her hometown of Bridgeton's economy, community spirit, social justice and respect for the diversity of its people." Whelan introduced Rainear stating, "Doug has dedicated his career at Bridgeton High School to improving the lives of all his students, helping hundreds of students in obtaining part-time employment. His record of service includes serving in local and county government, reflecting his commitment to serving others."

The Gary F. Simmerman Community Leadership Award was given to Bill Waterman, long-time educator at Bridgeton High School, and to the Cumberland County Historical Society for the unique service it performs for the community, preserving and promoting the historic buildings, sites, documents and events in Cumberland County. Bruce Riley recognized Waterman saying, "Bill's great love for the students he serves, his dedication to creating opportunities for them to succeed and his strong commitment to community involvement by him and his students, has earned for him our respect and gratitude." He added, "a great teacher like Bill makes learning fun and inspires students to seek success and encourages them to reach their potential.'

Laurie LaTorre, Chairperson of the Salute Awards, acknowledged the Historical Society commenting, "the society is recognized for the unique role its volunteers and employees play in preserving and creating public awareness of important buildings, documents and events that are part of the County's history.

The retail sector award winners were two Upper Deerfield businesses whose products and services bring smiles to their customers, especially during the warm days days of spring, summer and fall. Rita's Water Ice

Rowan College of South Jersey, was the keynote speaker, talking with passion and enthusiasm about the groundbreaking innovations already underway at the new college. It was formed in July 2019 through the merger of Rowan College of Gloucester County and Cumberland County College. The two campuses, one in Gloucester County and one in Cumberland County along with other education facilities, forms the Route 55 Corridor for Education and Medicine (Eds & Meds).

He highlighted the expanded educational opportunities for young people in the counties, the innovative ways the college provides savings for students and families getting their college education, and the job training they can do to help existing businesses meet their employment needs and to prepare people in the region for the jobs that new businesses coming to the area will provide.

The college carries the name "Rowan" and is closely partnering with Rowan University but it is an independent community college.

Dr. Keating urged the Chamber and its member businesses to communicate with him to let him know what their education and training needs are so they can help.

"We have an exciting opportunity to keep more of our smart, talented, well-educated young people here rather than continuing the past patterns of so many going to college out of the area, out of the state, and never returning here except to visit family."

Keating announced that classes will begin soon in Bridgeton at the Alms Center.




We added value for our Members with Business After Business meetings, Business Succession workshops and several joint meetings with other area Chambers and the Cumberland County Improvement Authority.


