

The meeting included information from Cumberland County Clerk Celeste Riley and Cumberland County Board of Elections Administrator Lizbeth Hernandez, regarding the ballots that were mailed to thousands of voters for the July 7 primary election in NJ. They explained the vote-by-mail procedures for the primary election that will allow thousands of voters to participate without going out to the public polling places

to help mitigate additional spread of the coronavirus. As of the writing of this article, no decisions from NJ on how the November general election will be conducted has been made. For election information please visit: www.cumberlandcountvvotes.com.

Cumberland County Planning Director Matthew Pisarski provided information of the status of the census in Cumberland County, urging all businesses, residents and organizations to remind those they have contact with to fill out the census form. It only takes a few minutes and can help obtain millions of dollars in federal funding for our area, if we can raise our response levels. He thanked the Chamber of Commerce and CDC for

assisting in the promotion of the census, including partnering on a recent mailing to residents who do not receive mail at their homes, who get mail only through a post office box. To complete the census






