Dr. Robin Weinstein is the founder and President of the M25 Initiative, a nonprofit that works to empower and mobilize individuals and organizations in Cumberland County to employ innovative and cooperative solutions to feed the hungry, end poverty, reduce crime, revitalize a spirit of community and transform lives.

He is co-founder of the Cumberland County Housing First Collaborative, founding Pastor of Bethany Grace Community Church in Bridgeton and is Associate Professor in the College of Business at Wilmington University.

During the current COVID-19 pandemic, his


leadership has helped other local organizations with grants, bringing relief to many people in Bridgeton and Cumberland County.

The owner of Golden Pigeon Restaurnt, Mr. Ozkan Akilli, and his em-





