# Marijuana in NJ: Don't Let Your Business Go Up in Smoke

On February 23, Megan Knowlton Balne of Hyland Levin Shapiro LLP, made a presentation at the Bridgeton Area Chamber of Commerce Membership and Networking online meeting looking at the legalization of recreational Marijuana in New Jersey and how employers may be affected.

"In November 2020, the voters of New Jersey approved a constitutional amendment legalizing the use of Marijuana for residents 21 years of age and older, said Megan Balne. She



added, "this law and the regulations regarding employees' use of Marijuana will have a dramatic effect on employers."

Megan explained: the New Jersey Cannabis Regulatory, Enforcement Assistance, and Marketplace Modernization Act, signed into

*law February 22, 2021 includes specific requirements for when and how an employer may take adverse action against an employee for cannabis use.* 

She pointed to the following provisions of the new law designed to protect NJ residents who choose the use cannabis that will make it harder for employers to deal with workplace issues that may be related to cannabis use by employees.

- ⇒ No employer shall refuse to hire or employ any person or shall discharge from employment or take any adverse action against any employee with respect to compensation, terms, conditions, or other privileges of employment because that person does or does not smoke, vape, aerosolize or otherwise use cannabis items
- ⇒ However, an employer may require an employee to undergo a drug test upon reasonable suspicion of an employee's usage of a cannabis item while engaged in the performance of the employee's work responsibilities
- $\Rightarrow$  Or upon finding any observable signs of intoxication related to usage of a cannabis item
- ⇒ Or following a work-related accident subject to investigation by the employer
- ⇒ The employer may utilize the results of that drug test when determining the appropriate employment action concerning the employee, including, but not limited to dismissal, suspension, demotion, or other disciplinary action."

According to Megan, the new law creates a new certification and designation of a "Workplace Impairment Recognition Expert."



This is the Legislature's attempt to "better ensure the protections for prospective employees and employees against refusals to hire or employ, or against being discharged or having another adverse action taken by an employer, while simultaneously supporting the authority of employers to require employees undergo drug tests as well as employer efforts to maintain a drug and alcohol-free workplace or other drug or alcohol workplace policy."

Workplace Impairment Recognition Expert must attain a certification in accordance with new regulations (that have not been passed yet).

## **NJ Business Action Center Provides Help to Businesses**

On Feb. 26 the Bridgeton Area Chamber presented a free online workshop about the services available to businesses from the NJ Business Action Center (NJBAC), which is a part of the NJ Department of State.

Minerva Alvarado, Chairwoman of the Chamber's Education Programs Committee, Chamber Corporate Secretary, and Marketing Development Specialist for SERVPRO of Cape May and Cumberland Counties, hosted the meeting and welcomed guest speaker Melanie Willoughby, Executive Director of the NJBAC. Minerva recognized Cumberland Development Corporation (CDC) and Cooperative Business Assistance Corporation (CBAC) for their co-sponsorship of this workshop.



Tony Stanzione, who serves as the Executive Director of the CDC and the Chamber, explained the history of CDC, its mission of encouraging economic development and intergovernmental cooperation and its long partnership with CBAC and the Chamber, which helped create CDC in the middle 1990's.
