The Chamber Leads a Discussion About **“Hispanic Business: The Power of a Culture”**

The Bridgeton Area Chamber of Commerce (“BACC”) and representatives of partnering chambers met to discuss “Hispanic Business: The Power of a Culture.” Over 100 business and community professionals gathered at the ALMS Center and on Zoom on June 15. The keynote speakers were invited to start the conversation about the potential of Hispanic business owners in the area and how to maximize their positive impact to the local economy, including a revitalization plan for Downtown Bridgeton.

Luis De La Hoz, Vice President of Community Lending at Valley Bank in Wayne and Chairman of the Statewide Hispanic Chamber of Commerce of New Jersey, the largest chamber in the state of New Jersey, traveled over two hours to attend in-person. He led the conversation by stating: “There are over 61 million Hispanic Americans in the United States. Hispanics are the principal driver of the nation’s demographic growth. Hispanic entrepreneurs are the fastest growing segment of business owners and today, Hispanic entrepreneurs own one out of every seven small businesses in the United States.” He added, “It is very important to follow through with community outreach to build relationships in Hispanic business communities - because when you connect to the heart

"As often happens, Cumberland County gets less resources from other levels of government, and/or they are slower to arrive," commented Derella. "Being prepared and having experience working harder with less resources, we saw our health department work tirelessly in partnership with others, to get testing, contact tracing, and Covid-19 information out to the community, quickly, professionally, fairly, and efficiently."

Derella also praised the way the leaders of the county's 14 municipalities have worked together on this crisis.

Don Fauerbach and Megan Sheppard of the Cumberland County Department of Health explained the many hurdles that were in front of them and their relatively small department as the Covid-19 pandemic struck the area in early 2020. "Our training and preparation for health issues like this really helped," said Sheppard.

"Because we are small, we are experienced in collaborating to make the best of the somewhat limited resources we have," Sheppard added. She thanked her staff and the many volunteers, who stepped up in this public health crisis.





NJ Wind Port Project Offers Big Opportunities for Jobs and Development

The meeting was sponsored by Cumberland County Department of Workforce Development.

Following an introduction by Christy DiLeonardo of Cumberland Workforce Department, Julia Kortrey, Senior Project Officer at NJ EDA, talked about the project and its importance to New Jersey's economy and especially Salem County and Southern New Jersey. "This project will make NJ the epicenter of this development industry off the east coast. Governor Murphy's 2022 state budget includes \$200 million for the project," stated Kortrey. Kortrey added, "construction is targeted to start in 2021 and the port should open in 2023. It represents \$300-400 million in green infrastructure investment."
