

Help to Build a Stronger Workforce

Patricia Mooneyham, Assistant Director, Business Development Career and Technical Education Division at Rowan College of South Jersey (RCSJ), and Christy DiLeonardo, Business Services Division Director of Cumberland County Department of Workforce Development (County Workforce Development), two experienced experts in workforce development led the presentation at the Chamber's Jan. 25 networking and education meeting.

The meeting was held in person at our Chamber Member. The Green Olive Restaurant in Hopewell and via Zoom. The meeting sponsor was Charles Schwab Vineland-Millville. Don Daigle spoke about

the company and his independent office that serves the county. He explained, "we help make it easy for you to be an informed investor at Schwab. The world of investing is nuanced, so with the support of the experts at Charles Scwab, we provide information, easy-to-search articles on everything from today's market and tomorrow's forecasts to investing and tax strategies to help you meet your financial goals." For more information visit www.schwab.com/vineland-millville.

Patricia Mooneyham talked about the many valuable workforce development and training services RCSJ provides in partnership with others including Christy DiLeonardo's County Workforce Development Services, NJ Department of Labor, NJ Business and Industry Association Business Solutions Team.

Services include building top, middle and first-line management skills in technical areas, human relations, and conceptual. "We provide assessments to see what areas need strengthening in your business, and then design training sessions to meet those needs," Mooneyham explained. The core assessments include behavioral, motivational, thinking, emotional and learning.

RCSJ and County Workforce Department work together to help employers take advantage of a wide range of grant funded training and recruiting services. RCSJ also provided affordable management training programs. For more information visit career training at www.rcsj.edu.

Christy DiLeonardo urged businesses to contact her and the team at the County Workforce Development to find out more about the services that they can provide. "We are here to assist with recruiting, retaining, and strengthening your most im-

portant asset, your employees," she commented.

DiLeonardo highlighted the On the Job Training (OJT) grant program where employers who hire for full-time positions that pay \$12 per hour -County, \$13 per hour—State, or more are reimbursed 50% of the salary (capped at \$6000-County & \$10,000-state) for agreeing to provide training for a period of up to 26 weeks to an unemployed jobseeker or a public assistance recipient. Employers who hire individuals receiving public assistance may also be eligible for no -cost, six-month, \$25,000 federal bonds. She added that the program is a cost-effective way to Minerva Alvarado, fill your positions with job-ready, prescreened candidates. 

Service providers will connect from this infrastructure to the home or business, also known as the "last mile". The goal is to extend reliable, high-speed internet service all across the county.
